## Strong test awaits Bourdy's title defence

**Grégory Bourdy will face an impressive field including The 1999 Open Champion Paul Lawrie and former winners Paul Broadhurst and Pablo Martin when he defends his Estoril Open de Portugal title this week.**

The Frenchman (pictured above) returns to Oitavos Dunes, in Estoril, where he captured his second European Tour title last year, defeating Scotland's Alastair Forsyth and England's David Howell in a play-off after the trio tied on 18 under par 266 in regulation play.

Both Forsyth (pictured below right), who finished fifth in last week's Open de Andalucia de Golfe 09, and Howell are again included in the field for the 53rd edition of the tournament, along with Forsyth's compatriot Lawrie who this season celebrates the tenth anniversary of his most famous win when he memorably defeated Bourdy's compatriot Jean Van De Velde and Justin Leonard of the USA in a play-off at Carnoustie to win the Claret Jug.

They will be joined in Estoril by Estanislao Goya and Anders Hansen, two players who have already tasted success on The 2009 European Tour International Schedule.

Argentine Goya will be looking for his second victory in Portugal in three weeks having captured his maiden European Tour title in the Madeira Islands Open BPI - Portugal last month.

The 20 year old survived a late birdie blitz from Scotland's Callum Macaulay at Porto Santo Golfe to win in just his sixth start on The European Tour.

Meanwhile Dane Hansen, winner of the BMW PGA Championship in 2002 and 2007, will be chasing his fourth European Tour title having

already triumphed in the Joburg Open at the start of January.

There will also be a strong Spanish contingent led by Gonzalo Fernandez-Castaño and Pablo Larrazabal, both of whom won European Tour titles in 2008.

Irish Ryder Cup player Paul McGinley, a four time European Tour winner, will also tee up in Estoril along with compatriot Damien McGrane, winner of the Volvo China Open last year, who finished in a tie for third behind Goya in Madeira.

Nine-time European Tour champion Thomas Björn of Denmark, another former Ryder Cup player, is also in the field, as is Europe's 2002 Ryder Cup winning Captain Torrance, winner of the DGM Barbados Open on the European Senior Tour earlier this month, who makes a rare outing on The European Tour, adding to his record 704 appearances.

## DID YOU KNOW?

- Pablo Martin made European Tour history when he became the first amateur to win, claiming the Estoril Open de Portugal in 2007. Martin's success was followed by New Zealander Danny Lee at the 2009 Johnnie Walker Classic.
- Defending champion, Grégory Bourdy produced a piece of European Tour history after defeating Alastair Forsyth and David Howell in a play-off. Following on from Thomas Levet's success in the Open de Andalucia seven days earlier, Bourdy's win marked the first time two different French golfers had won consecutive events on The European Tour.
- Since the event became part of The European Tour International Schedule in 1973, it has seen many players claim their maiden European Tour title. They include: Jamie Benito (1973), Hal Underwood (1975), Salvador Balbuena (1976), Manuel Ramos (1977), Howard Clark (1978), Tony Johnstone (1984), Warren Humphreys (1985), Mike Harwood (1988), Colin Montgomerie (1989), Mike McLean (1990), Phillip Price (1994), Adam Hunter (1995), Michael Jonzon (1997), Van Phillips (1999), Gary Orr (2000), Carl Pettersson (2002) and Pablo Martin (2007).

## From the Open de Andalucia de Golf 09



More often than not, it is a golfer's consistency throughout the week of a tournament that is significant in his overall victory. But on the odd occasion, there is one round so special in its brilliance that it transcends all others. For Søren Kjeldsen and the Open de Andalucia de Golf 09, that moment came on Saturday. The Dane's ten under par third round 62 was virtually golfing perfection; a new course record at Real Club de Golf de Sevilla featuring a run of seven birdies in a row from the seventh. Not surprisingly, Kjeldsen's accuracy towards the greens and his precision on them were the keys to his round, as a glance at the Genworth Financial Statistics show. On Saturday the Dane was Number One in the Greens in Regulation category with 88.9 per cent, as well as topping both the Putts per Greens in Regulation category with 1.5 and the Putts per Round category with 27 that day - figures which helped him finish in the top 15 of each of those respective categories over the week. Such skill on the greens obviously builds confidence and it was no surprise that when it came to the crunch on Sunday afternoon, Kjeldsen holed crucial putts on both the 16th and 17th to hold off the challenge of Scot David Drysdale.

#### PUTTS PER GIR

Defined as both the average number of putts taken per green in regulation and the average number of putts taken per round on greens that are hit in regulation. By doubling the greens per round figure and thereby assuming two putts on each green in regulation, we can then subtract the GIR putts per round figure from this total to infer the number of strokes under par the player will be per round from the greens hit in regulation.

#### AVERAGE PUTTS

Defined as the average number of putts taken per round. The use of the putter from off the green does not constitute a putt as far as the statistics are concerned.

#### SCRAMBLES

The frequency, expressed as a percentage to one decimal place, of the player scoring par or better on holes where the player missed the Green in Regulation.

## \* Edfors lands Black Mountain title

European Tour Member Johan Edfors of Sweden endured some nervous moments before completing a wire-to-wire victory at the Black Mountain Masters.

Edfors fired a four under par 68 in the final round at the Black Mountain Golf Club to triumph by two shots over Thailand's Prayad Marksaeng and England's Chris Rodgers in the inaugural event.

It was a timely victory for Edfors, who had not won a title following his bumper 2006 season where he triumphed three times on The European Tour.



## \* Casey wins European Tour Shot off the Month for February

Paul Casey's superb six iron strike for an eagle two during the final of the World Golf Championships – Accenture Match Play has been awarded The European Tour Shot of the Month for February.

Faced with a shot of some 197 yards, made more difficult because it was into the wind and downhill, the nine-time European Tour champion produced a perfect six iron, the ball checking beautifully on the putting surface before rolling into the hole.

## \* Ryder Cup Captains head for Majorca

Ryder Cup Captains Mark James, Sam Torrance and Ian Woosnam will headline one of the strongest fields of the 2009 European Senior Tour season when they tee up in the €300,000 inaugural Son Gual Mallorca Senior Open from May 8-10.

Scotsman Torrance, the current Senior Tour Order of Merit leader, will renew his battle for supremacy with Welshman Woosnam who claimed the John Jacobs Trophy in his rookie season in 2008.

In-form Torrance captured his 11th Senior Tour title -and his second in three appearances – in the last Senior Tour tournament when he won the DGM Barbados Open by four strokes.

## \* Björn backs Challenge Tour to produce the goods again

As its most successful graduate, Denmark's Thomas Björn is well placed to give his views on the importance of the Challenge Tour's role in nurturing new talent.
